
At the end of the Academic session an online Teachers Feedback on Curriculum of Course was conducted in the institution. 29 responses of the faculty were taken offline.

The survey was specified only for evaluating the Teaching and Learning Process in the institution.


In total 20 questions were asked to the faculty.












